

# THROCKMORTON AIR SHOW 2016



*IN SUPPORT OF*



The Throckmorton Air Show Organisers would like to advise the local residents of Throckmorton, Pinvin and Pershore of the forthcoming Air Show diversion routes.

These diversions are necessary due to the tragic events in 2015 at the Shoreham Air Show and also to prevent the unfortunate and unexpected delays that some people encountered last year. If you are not planning to attend the event we hope that you will not be inconvenienced in any way by the Air Show traffic.

A comprehensive and detailed Traffic Management Plan has been implemented for the 2016 Air Show and there will be three separate routes to the show with two public entry gates in use during the morning period.

For the safety of the public and to ensure that no vehicles will be parked along Throckmorton Road during the event, a full road closure will be in place from 11:30 at the junction with the A44. Access to Throckmorton village from the A44 will be for emergency traffic and local residents only (A valid residents pass must be shown).

For anyone wishing to travel through the Pinvin Traffic lights on Sat 11<sup>th</sup> June, please bear in mind there will be a manually operated set of traffic signals in use between 08:00am and 18:00pm. These manually operated lights will be a two way system only and all traffic wishing to travel to Pinvin, Worcester or Evesham from Pershore will need to follow the diversion signs towards the B4083 (Wyre Hill the left on to Wyre Road). Access to the Train station and industrial areas will still be available.

All traffic traveling to Pershore from Worcester and Pinvin will be required to travel along the A44 (Abby View Rad) before turning at the roundabout and returning to the manually operated signals and making a left turn only towards Pinvin. Traffic from Pinvin wishing to travel towards Worcester will be required to take the same action and follow the diversion signs towards the roundabout. There will be no right turn allowed from Pinvin towards Worcester and no right turn allowed from Worcester towards Pershore.

Long lane from the junction of Upton Snodsbury Road will be a one way system from 07:00am until approximately 13:00pm to allow the free flow of vehicles to enter the show. The flow will be reversed around the same time in the afternoon to allow the smooth flow of traffic leaving the event. A set of manually operated signals will be in use at the junction throughout the day.


The traffic management company will be monitoring the flow of traffic on the surrounding roads throughout the day, should there be any reason to close or open roads sooner than expected they may do so at short notice.

The Air Show Organisers would like to thank you in advance for your understanding and cooperation and hope you enjoy the show if you come along.

Please be aware the following picture is only a basic outline and not a scaled plan. This is only meant to advise the public of the diversion in place at the Pinvin Traffic lights, there is a full plan detailing the position and wording of all signs held with the relevant agencies concerned.

Please note that Throckmorton Road will have a “NO PARKING/NO WAITING” enforcement area, vehicles will be removed if left in the vicinity.

There will be no access to the public on the road surrounding the airfield either in a vehicle or as a pedestrian. After the tragedy at Shoreham the Air Show organisers will be complying with the CAA regulations and ensuring that no members of the public are within the aircraft display area. This restriction is for your own safety and to ensure the Air Show can be conducted in a safe manner. If any members of the public are seen by the FDD (Flying Display Director) to be standing around the perimeter fence he may stop the flying display programme. This will undoubtedly ruin the event for the members of the public who have bought advance tickets to support our chosen charities and also to have an enjoyable family day out. We would therefore ask people not to attempt to view the show from outside the perimeter fence.



The plan below is a detailed picture of the Pinvin traffic light junction. Please follow the signs that will lead you to your destination, the diversion is designed to keep the traffic flowing through the junction.
